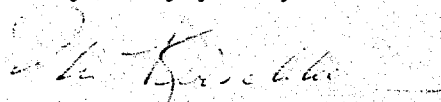
Dear Dr. Kehoe:

As a result of your meeting with Mr. W. F. Kindt on October 22, 1962, we have reviewed the changes that would be acceptable to you in our contract proposal for off-gas testing of our P-7 ranges.
