Health Menace of Tetra Ethyl Lead Gas Discussed by Scientists

Conferees Will Study Second Report of Bureau of Mines Investigation on Dangers of Auto Fuel

Leading scientists, chemists and physicians called by the Public Health Service to study reports regarding efforts on health of tetra-ethyl lead gas from autos, today will discuss finding at a conference here.

Because of the widespread use of autos in densely populated centers, and the effects of lead poisoning on the human system, Dr. Yandell Henderson, of Yale, says the problem of the conference is "probably the greatest single question in the field of public health."

Dr. Henderson was the first to call attention to the dangers of using lead in gasoline.

He criticized the Bureau of Mines for its report, in which it concluded there was no danger to public health in ethyl gasoline.

The Bureau of Mines is finishing a second investigation, and the re-

sults of the inquiry, along with findings of other chemists, will be studied.

Five persons died last fall as a result of working with the new gasoline in a producing plant.

Recently the Ethyl Gasoline Corporation suspended delivery in 27 states pending investigation.
