This will confirm our telephone conversation relative to gypsum ribs for use generally in laminated gypsum board partition work. Bestwall makes these ribs at several plants, show them available at practically all plants and have standardized generally on a 6" wide rib that is made by laminating two pieces of 1/2" board for a 1" rib, two pieces 5/8" board for 1 1/8" rib, two pieces of 1/2" board and one piece of 5/8" board for 1 5/8" rib, three pieces of 1/2" board for 2 1/8" ribs, two thicknesses of 5/8" and one thickness of 1/2" for 1 3/4" ribs. The following table lists the thickness of the rib, the F.O.B. Bestwall Mill prices, the billing weight per thousand square feet, the selling price of Bestwall to J/M for these ribs.

After the matter of Exhibit A for the contract is settled, these items will be among those added into that grouping.

Bestwall has standardized on a 6" wide rib for this use. These prices would apply if you wanted a wider rib, for narrower ribs you will have to ask for a price which may be higher because of the additional cutting.

Such ribs have been made at Miami and Ft. Dodge and we believe there is no problem there. They will not be made at New Orleans or Eastwall Kansas. While the ribs are indicated available at Akron and Iowa, Brunswick and Grand Rapids, this is subject to confirmation at the plant due to the fact that all of them do not have equal saw equipment and some plants will have problems with the three thickness ribs that others will not.

It is requested you try to give a plant as long notice as possible when you have a large quantity of ribs required for some commercial job to enable them to take full advantage of the time available to have the products at the lowest cost to Bestwall as possible.

This problem came up due to the necessity of furnishing ribs 1 1/2" thick by 8" on a Baltimore job.
