

RED BLUFF (AP)—A strict student dress code handed down by the school board has raised a protest among Red Bluff High School boys and girls.

The 13-point proclamation issued this week in the Tehama County district was headed by a frank warning: "Deviations from the dress standard is cause for suspension or expulsion."

But one student, Carolyn Morris, sets what appears to be the tone of the protest.

"I think we should be able to wear whatever we want as long as we still learn."

These are the rules:

1—Bermuda shorts and other abbreviated attire will not be permitted on campus during school hours.

2—Girls shall not wear slacks or any attire that resembles slacks. Dresses with side slits and "beach type" shifts are not permitted.

3—Clothing shall be neat, clean—and—fit properly. Dress shall not be so tight as to be distracting, or to impair freedom of movement.

4—Shirts and blouses designed to be worn inside pants or skirts must be worn inside.

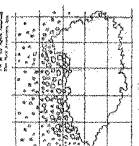
5—Skirt lengths should reach within two inches of the knee or lower.

6—Boys shirts will be buttoned with the exception of the collar button.

7—Boys pants shall be conventional slacks or

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Jeans properly adjusted to the waistline.

8—Shoes must be worn at all times.

9—Boys will be expected to be clean shaven at all times. Sideburns will not extend below a point even with the middle of the ear opening.

10—Boys' hair will be groomed in such a way that the hair does not fall over the ears or does not

be "tapered" nearly above the collar.

11—Girls' hair styles will not hide the face and will be neat in appearance.

12—Appropriate costumes for special school activities must be approved by the student council and the school administration.

13—Garments with writing, freehand drawings, designs or stenciled drawing that could be interpreted to designate a private group or club are prohibited.

A statement introduced the rules:

"The board of trustees of the Red Bluff Union High School District feels that there is a positive relationship between a pupil's appearance, his attitudes, conduct, and seriousness of purpose, and that it is the responsibility of the school to set standards of appearance and deportment and to teach good grooming consistent with basic community standards."

One boy helping circulate a protest petition says, "We want to be heard out. We weren't consulted beforehand."

"We were just handed the rules," said the youth who preferred to remain anonymous to newsmen.

Principal Floyd Salisbury said there were "few signatures" on the petition as of today.

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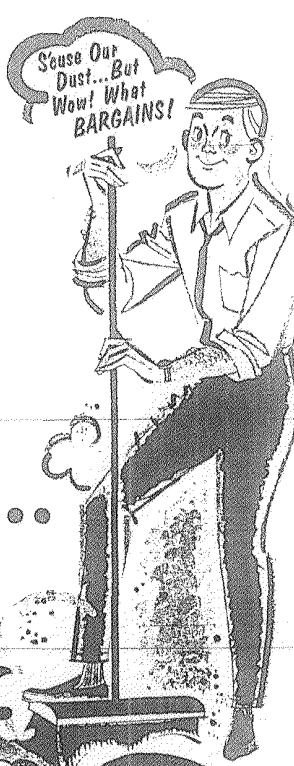
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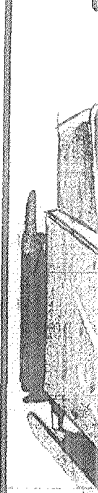
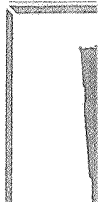
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
