Persons who witnessed the aftermath of the explosion describe the resultant yellowish smoke as resembling a slowly rising mushroom which eventually spread a pall of smoke over the surrounding country and San Pablo Bay.

Quick action on the part of a hastily organized rescue party prevented fire from the debris spreading to other sections of the big plant and causing more serious damage.

Mike Hattich, powder, line foreman, who narrowly escaped death by the explosion, gave newspapermen a vivid description of the accident.

"When I was within a few hundred feet of the structure the explosion came," he said. "It seemed that the whole world was blowing up. I saw the building one moment and the next there was that awful blast. Then I saw a great mushroom of smoke, fire and debris hurtle into the air."

"Then I must have fallen, stunned. When I came to, workmen were rushing to the place where the shot had been. I helped them put out the fire and assisted in finding the bodies of the four dead men. It was the closest escape from a horrible death that I have ever had. Another minute, and I'd have been
