Beginning its fourth season of concerts, the ensemble originally was named the Napa Concert Band. Bertil Van Boer, professor of music and director of bands at the Napa College, is conductor of the wind ensemble. He previously held similar positions at Florida State University, University of British Columbia and the Pacific Union College.

Band musicians from the entire North Bay Area are invited to join the ensemble in their initial rehearsal to be held in the music room of the Library Building on the college campus. Those desiring college credit for participation may also register during the first rehearsal.
