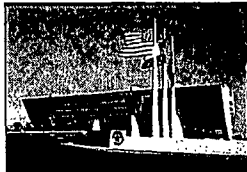


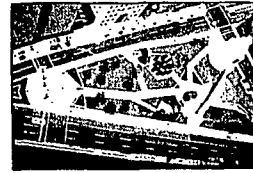

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The City

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from Dallas, as well as travel within the city itself, embodies the two prime requirements of today's traveler: convenience and speed.

Most travelers arrive at the nation's largest commercial airport, Dallas/Fort Worth. This space age airport, which serves travelers as a virtually self-contained community all its own, sets the pace among the airports of the world with more than 20 regular service air carriers providing over 200,000 seats daily. In addition, Love Field (near downtown Dallas) provides another 34,000 seats daily on two regional air carriers.

Both airports are also served by a number of commuter and charter airlines.

Surtran express coach service to and from the Dallas/Fort Worth airport is provided on a scheduled basis at a very reasonable rate. In addition, taxis operate from the airport around the clock at affordable fees. Air taxi service is also available to numerous locations.

For those who prefer to reach Dallas on the ground, Trailways and Greyhound Bus Lines provide regularly scheduled trans-continental bus connections. Additionally, Amtrak, the national passenger train, transports Dallas-bound travelers to and from the city.

For those travelers opting to drive to the NAPA National Business Conference, Dallas sits on seven spokes of the Interstate Highway system branching out in all directions. Fourteen additional major highways lead motorists into Dallas, and the city is circled by two giant highway loops.

Whichever mode of travel you choose,

and whichever direction you're coming from, the way to downtown Dallas is swift and simple.

THE FAIRMONT HOTEL
