SUBJECT VINYL TOPPING

We have had a number of requests in the Southern California area for a vinyl ready mix that is made as a topping product. Samples of Willie Hamilton's were furnished to Tom Smith about three or four months ago and should be at Paco now.

The general opinion here is that a topping-type ready mix has less shrinkage and is easier sanding and actually has a great deal of acceptance in lieu of an all-purpose product in certain shops where they feel they get better workability along with the easier sanding and lower shrinkage level.

Would you please review the topping type vinyl ready mix of which Willie Hamilton's appears to be the best although Kasier and U.S.G. are also making one now and advise if you feel one can be made for us.
