Gentlemen:

This refers to your proposed use of the rigid "Vinylite" resin in the manufacture of dog tags for human identification purposes. These resins are essentially inert. We have made limited patch test study of them and they show little or no sensitizing effect. We would anticipate no difficulty from their use in this way and they should cause no more irritation than materials commonly used for making these dog tags. These resins have been used for over fifteen years in making dentures for humans, and we have received no report of difficulty from such use.
