HOUSE PAINT KILLS BABY

Son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert A. Mooney licked his stained fingers.

Services were held today for David Mooney, two and a half-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Robert A. Mooney, 22 North Avenue, Wyncote, who died after licking house paint from his stained fingers.

The boy developed lead poisoning about three weeks ago and this led to encephalitis, or sleeping sickness, according to Montgomery County Coroner Winslow J. Rushong. He died Tuesday in Abington Memorial Hospital, Abington, Pa., four days after he was admitted.

Burial was in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery.

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
