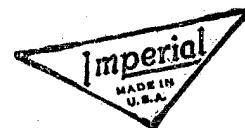

Brief Summary

Tank #22 - Standard Oil Company, River Rouge, Michigan - April 1932

Little relevant history of the tank is known, excepting that it had been idle for about 60 days after pump down and that bottom sludge contained 0.50% organic lead.

Patients are reported en mass. All had same symptoms excepting two who reported constipation. All cases were mild and apparently were all well within a few days.

5 men involved on job
5 men worked within tank
5 men were mildly ill

Factors responsible:

1. Failure to wear mask
2. Tank was idle 60 days before cleaning
3. Organic lead in sludge 0.50%
