Dear Sir,

JOHNS MANVILLE CORPORATION. We have been advised by the Johns Manville Corporation that Mr. Barron, Assistant to the Vice President and General Manager of the Fibre Division, will be available to visit Wittenoom shortly.

We are arranging for Mr. Borrer also Mr. K.O. Brown and Mr. M.G. King to arrive at Wittenoom on Wednesday 26th March and they will stay until about the following Tuesday 1st April. If the Perth Engineer cannot arrange for a plane on the Wednesday then the party will arrive on Tuesday 25th March.

We are not sure what days the planes fly down the coast from Roebourne but we have asked Mr. Wallace to advise us on this matter. It is planned to return to Perth via Roebourne and we think it may be best, to enable Mr. Borrer to see the country if he is taken to Roebourne by road, However that can be discussed at Wittenoom.

We have asked Johns Manville whether they wish to be interested in the future development of Wittenoom and the purpose of Mr. Borrer's visit is to gain sufficient information so that his Company can decide in what way they may wish to be interested. We are prepared to give Mr. Borrer any information that he requests on the performance & finances of the Company.

So that you may see what we have said to Johns Manville we now enclose a copy of our letter of 30th January 1952 to Mr. A.R. Fisher. This letter is quite confidential, of course, and should be seen only by yourself and Mr. Broadhurst.
