It is my understanding that a test of Mr. [REDACTED] blood at this time would be of no value as far as relating his present illness to any exposure to lead from paint at Willys Motors, Inc. prior to May 1, 1954. Similarly, it is my understanding that further information as to any urinalyses performed in 1959, or after, would likewise be of no value as far as establishing a relationship between Mr. [REDACTED] illness and lead exposure prior to May, 1954.
