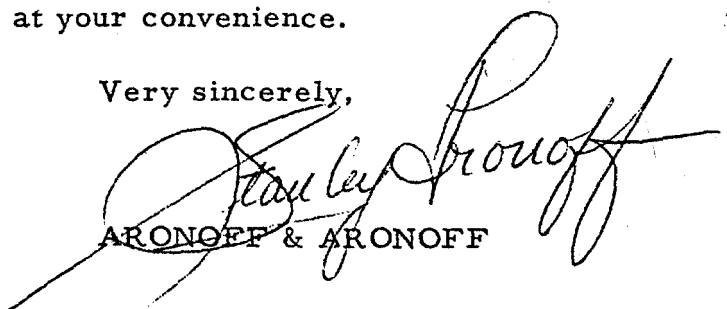
In Re: DIXON vs ROSICHAN
LEAD POISONING

Due to mounting problems of legal liability in the above case, I found it advisable to file same on August 26, 1959. Although the filing elicited some inquiries from both Cincinnati newspapers, they honored my request to hold publicity until your return from San Francisco.

In our conference just prior to your departure, we had contemplated a campaign for public education and legislation. Our strategy was to invite various interested and influential people to a discussion of the problems created by the rising number of lead poisoning cases and releasing the results to the newspapers. It was hoped that the combination of a lawsuit, public sentiment, and an election year would result in favorable legislation.

I think the time is now ripe to follow through with that program, especially since the council campaigns have begun. I shall be happy to discuss this with you at your convenience.
