Paint Labeling
Mr. Holton reported on two meetings held in New York City, one under the auspices of the American Standards Association and the other, the National Paint, Varnish & Lacquer Association. The ASA has developed a proposed standard which would permit paint manufacturers to label their product "conforms with American Standards Z-66-1 for use on surfaces which might be chewed by children". To use such a statement on the label would require that the product meet the two following requirements.

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
