SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS - CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS

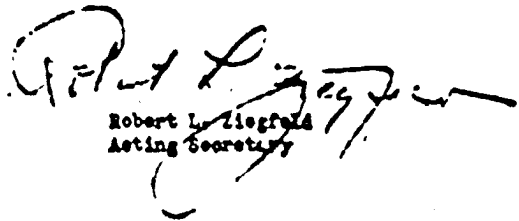
The Board of Directors of the Lead Industries Association has unanimously approved the attached amendments to the Constitution and By-Laws.

The purpose of the amendment to the Constitution is to make manufacturers of such articles as storage batteries, cable, ammunition, etc., eligible for regular membership as they are at present only eligible for associate membership. This would restore the status which existed before N.R.A. at which time the Government requested the Association to change its Constitution to exclude these groups of manufacturers.

The purpose of the amendment to the By-Laws is:

(1) To provide for subscriptions from manufacturers of such items as storage batteries, cable, ammunition, etc., on a tonnage basis similar to other regular members, (2) to provide a higher minimum subscription as a result of increased operating costs and services of the Association, and (3) to provide a uniform means of assessing producers of lead in foreign countries who export to the United States.
