This is our concrete technical specification for the parts of the Annex XV report on AFFF that we are cooperating with the UPFAS project on. This strategy was described in the AFFF PAIR.

The document is also an opportunity to give the five countries preparing the proposal an informal steer on how they could approach some of the aspects of the technical analysis, based on our experience with similar large dossiers, the evaluation of recent PFAS proposals in RAC and our observations on the progress of various work packages of the UPFAS project.

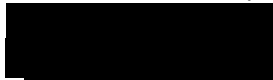

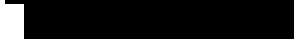
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
