Dear Colleen Zimmerman:

This letter concerns the above-referenced FOIA request, received by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA or Agency) on July 2, 2025, in which you requested, enforcement actions that have not been resolved (NOVs, FOV's and Inspection Reports).

Your request seeks records that have been previously requested and these records are available via the PAL link contained within the response email. You may also access responsive documents at: <https://foiapublicaccessportal.epa.gov/app/ReadingRoom.aspx>. When you are in the Reading Room, go to the bottom of the page and limit the search to Region 8 only, then enter “*2025-EPA-04364*” and “*2025-EPA-04686*” in the “Name” field for each of the previously requested FOIAs concerning Inspection Reports, NOV’s and FOV’s.

EPA has considered the foreseeable harm standard when reviewing records and applying FOIA exemptions.

Some of the released records contain information that has been withheld pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(6) (Personally Identifiable Information); (b)(7)(A) (Interfere with pending enforcement proceedings); (b)(7)(C) (unwarranted invasion of personal privacy); (b)(7)(E) (techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecution).

Please note that this is an interim response, and the EPA continues to work on your request. The Agency expects to complete its response to your request by October 1, 2026 pending review of documents from the Department of War.

Again, your request is not being closed at this time. When your request is closed, you will receive information concerning your appeal rights for any part of EPA’s response.
