The meeting was called to order at 10:15 A.M.

The committee proceeded to a consideration of the report of 1957 activities and recommendations for 1958, circulated to the committee on October 29, 1957. A letter from Mr. Roger H. Cutting expressing substantial agreement with the recommendations was read.

After considerable discussion, it was regularly moved, seconded and carried that current activities be conducted in 1958 on the same basis as 1957 with an annual budget of \$47,000; that the study of the potentialities of lead in the building construction field by the firm of Skidmore, Owings & Merrill be undertaken but confined to the first phase only, at a cost of \$20,000, plus or minus 10 percent; that the report submitted by Skidmore, Owings & Merrill be considered at the end of the first phase of the study and decision made at that time as to whether the second phase would be necessary and, if necessary, just what form it should take. The study would also be used as a basis for reconsideration of the regular activities of this Division.

Meeting was adjourned at 11:30 A.M.
