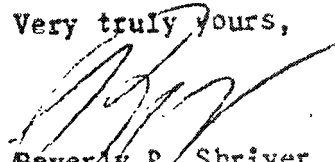

According to our records, Mr. Faulkner was never employed by the South Gate Plant.

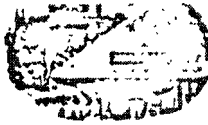
