. . . we listened to the radio, where EPA Administrator Scott Pruitt is alluding to the possibility of reviewing the prior administration's finding that greenhouse gas emissions endanger public health and welfare, a landmark document that forms the basis of all of the agency's climate regulations.

Over in China, California Gov. Jerry Brown (D) is signing a series of clean energy technology development deals with Chinese officials and touting the efforts as trailblazing on climate change amid retreats by the Trump administration.

In personnel news, President Donald Trump announced his intent to nominate a former George W. Bush Department of Justice (DOJ) official – who later represented the U.S. Chamber of Commerce in a suit targeting the Obama EPA's early GHG rules – to head DOJ's environment division.

And our daily news roundup looked at how new coalitions of states, cities and companies are pledging to continue to work toward achieving Obama's GHG reduction target under the Paris Agreement even after Trump vowed to leave the deal.
