Wittenoom Mines

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The Manager,
Australian Blue Asbestos Ltd.

Workmen's Inspector, J. Hunt, Ventilation Inspector
M. Simmons and myself have this day completed a ventilation
check up and general inspection of the workings in the Colonial
Mine and Mill.

We wish to draw your attention to the following:-

Dust from the Mill exhaust is interfering with
general ventilation and this must be stopped.

Equipment which is longer than the top of underground
locomotives must not be carried on locomotives. Short equip-
ment may be carried if it is secured in racks.

The ventilation record book does not contain the
information required by our Act.

Afternoon shift inspections have shown that the break
between day and afternoon shifts is inadequate in that the mine
air has not time to become clear. It is suggested that shifts
be arranged so that there is a break of 2½ hours between day
shift and afternoon shift for underground workers. This will
be of great benefit to the health of underground men.
