I have given considerable thought to publishing the study on "Air Sampling for Asbestos Fibers in Buildings Using Asbestos Based Products in Construction." I have come to the conclusion that the study is not of sufficient magnitude to be entirely conclusive and I feel that rebuttal against the concerted efforts of a few people in the medical profession against the use of asbestos for any purpose will need an overwhelming collection of data. The collection of data to the contrary is supported by a considerable amount of funds, some of which you know, is supplied by the federal government for research grants.

It seems now that it would not be propitious to publish a short note at this time.
