George Fague requested that I write you with reference to
Hydraul 312 which is used at Pontiac.

Chlorinated biphenyls refers to a family of chemical products,
some of which are used in our Hydraul product line. Hydraul
312 does contain chlorinated biphenyl, however, we have no
evidence that the particular chlorinated biphenyls used in
Hydraul 312 are highly toxic to aquatic life.

Monsanto has many studies underway (some for over a year)
to determine the effect of the entire chlorinated biphenyl
family on environment. Once these studies are completed
we will be able to comment further. We hope to have
sufficient results in the first quarter of 1970.
