Dear Sirs,

Referring to your letter ACT/GB of Oct. 20th 1939 I wish to report that owing to the fact that lead in the urine is one of the first symptoms of the poisoning, I had these tests taken. As I have no laboratory at my disposal, I had the urine tested at a Batavia Laboratory.

In my letter of June 7th 1939 I agreed that all additional expenses should be charged extra. In my opinion it is therefore quite regular that I have sent in the bill.

In addition to above mentioned I quite agree that the urine tests need not be taken every three months; it is my opinion after the tests taken that once a year will be sufficient in the future.

In case you think it unnecessary to take these yearly urine tests, I will leave these out of the examinations.
