Dear Mr. Moore:

Mr. [REDACTED] was examined August 30, 1944. There was no evidence found which would support a diagnosis of lead intoxication and analysis of the blood for lead showed a lead level not in excess of normal unexposed individuals.

It is the opinion of this examiner that Mr. [REDACTED] symptoms were produced by absorption of gasoline vapours while cleaning tank cars. This opinion, however, could in no way be construed as incontestable since there are many other intoxicants which could have produced the same results.
