Advantages

1. No need for expensive SID cylinders.
2. Offers opportunity of using glass fibers as reinforcement-possible asbestos free product.
3. Yields precision molded product.
4. Visual appearance (air holes, square corners) of product superior to Kaylo-on par with Johns-Manville Thermobestos.

Disadvantages

1. Batch costs higher than those for Kaylo.
2. Process more complicated-involves cooking of batch.
3. Process requires filter press to form product.
4. Product more expensive than Kaylo to produce-on par with Johns-Manville Thermobestos manufacturing costs.
5. Not adaptable to Berlin pan pouring process.
6. Higher density product (all filter press products have higher densities than Kaylo).
7. Inferior physical and handling properties.
