NEW YORK, MAY 11, 1961 - Erich K. Zimmermann has been appointed manager Oncor pigment sales at National Lead Company's New York office. He succeeds Karel Vettewinkel who has retired after 32 years of service.

Joining National Lead in 1937 at the Titanium Division's Paint, Paper and Rubber Service Laboratory in New York City, Mr. Zimmermann directed development work on the application of titanium pigments in industrial finishes until 1941 at which time he became manager of the laboratory. In 1950 he was transferred to the company's research laboratories at Brooklyn to direct the paint, pigment and coatings research and development activities and in 1953 he was appointed assistant technical director.

Mr. Zimmermann received his degree in chemical engineering as well as his M.S. in chemistry from Lehigh University.
