Ed Kaiser has introduced Santicizer 278 and Santicizer 1707 to all of the polysulfide compounds. While making his presentation at Sonneborn, he determined that the test they use for compatibility is the following.

Take 100 parts of LP-32, 100 parts of plasticizer and 15 parts of paste. If this combination produces a fully cured rubber, then it is considered compatible under any circumstance. We've told them that the test may be fine but it doesn't say much for compatibility stability which should of course cause concern.

Your work on helping us maintain what we have and regain what we've lost has been immensely important. I believe we have good odds on getting all of this business back including that which we never had before. Every presentation has generated enough interest to have all of the customers commit themselves to an evaluation of both Santicizer 278 and Santicizer 1707.

As we get more information, we'll be sure you are kept informed.
