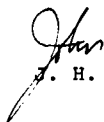

Attached is the information we discussed regarding an EPS Corporate guideline for sale of PCB contaminated equipment. Note the statement in parentheses in paragraph one.

Recent inquiries regarding sale of the "remains" of the PCB incinerator at WGK have prompted a review of this guideline. My discussions with you, Bill Papageorge and Dan Bishop confirm my initial reaction that this is probably a reasonable guideline. Our exposure and liability, both financially and from a media/PR aspect, could suffer more than the benefits we have derived from the small amount of revenue generated from such a sale.

In short, Dan Bishop and I support a Corporate guideline prohibiting sale of PCB contaminated equipment and we believe that Clayton Callis and Bill Papageorge would do likewise. Please review this with the appropriate DEO/EPS as soon as possible.
