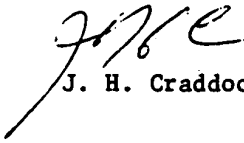

Fendett Corporation, St. Charles, Illinois, was identified in the Post Dispatch by the State Department of Natural Resources as one of 14 major contaminated hazardous waste sites in Missouri which present environmental health hazards.

Fendett was identified as a reprocessor of PCBs and PCB products from 1963-1974.

Fendett did perform contract work for MIC Functional Fluids Business Group and currently is an outside contractor for MIC.

The site was one identified as "time bombs that at some point are going to cause major environmental problems" by the State DNR Director and was used as justification for a ten year \$50M State Superfund Program.
