Gentlemen:

Mr. Frederick Miller, industrial hygienist of this Division evaluated employees' exposure to fibrous glass dust in your printed circuit board department on 26 May and on 21 September 1966. The survey was conducted at the request of Mr. Lewis Harro, superintendent of manufacturing.

Samples of the work atmosphere in the breathing zone of the workers were collected on pre-weighed membrane filters and the final weight was determined in terms of fibrous glass dust.

The results are given in the attached table. They indicate that employees' exposure to fibrous glass dust is less than the tentative threshold limit value of 5 milligrams per cubic meter of air.

We enclose a copy of dust exposures and a copy of Article 432, as amended.

Thank you for your cooperation in enabling this survey to be conducted.
