Subject VCM DOSIMETRY RESULTS FOR NOVEMBER

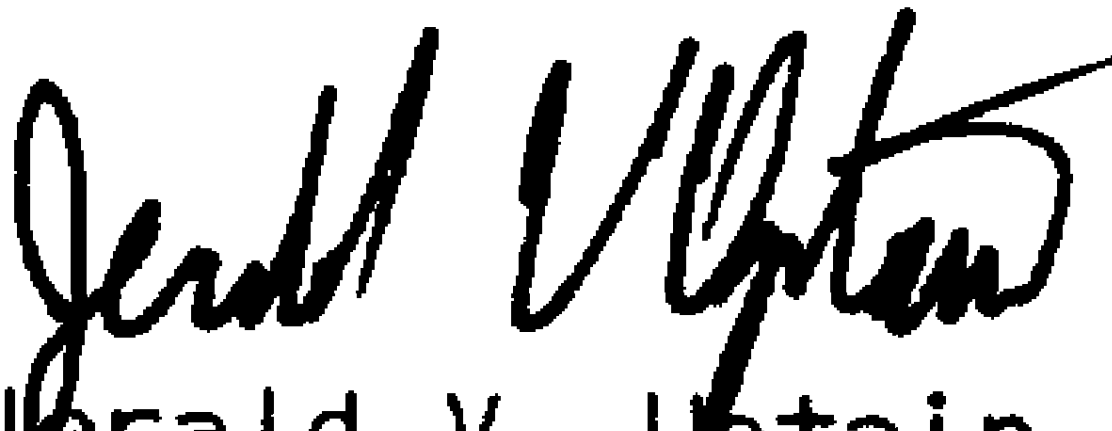
Following are the results of VCM Dosimetry during November. 22 samples were taken, with two results above the exposure limit.

One of the overexposures, amounting to 32.7 ppm, occurred while a maintenance mechanic was changing out a VCM "Corken" compressor at the VCM tank farm. He was wearing an air line respirator.

The second overexposure, amounting to 1.9 ppm, was experienced by a large reactor lead operator. No reason for the result has been found.

The employee was not wearing a respirator.
