

Breaking Korean Agreements

Oct 20 (UP)—Lt. Hodge, former American occupation force, said today that he has broken 16 of the agreements made in Korea during the war.

At a meeting of the Monterey Foreign Relations Club, Hodge said that Russian occupation forces have broken 16 of the agreements made in Korea during the war.

Hodge's first move since his return from Korea was to break the zones before the war when it was necessary to divide the country into a Russian half and an American half, he said.

Each bid shall be in accordance with the plans, specifications and other contract documents prepared by Robert Stanton A. I. A. Architect, Carmel, California, and shall be submitted on forms supplied by the Board. Copies of the documents are on file at the Office of the Board and the Architect and may be obtained by depositing the fee of \$10.00 with the Secretary of the Board or with the Architect for each set so obtained. Deposits will be refunded when the documents are returned within three (3) days after the bid opening date. Wage schedules shall be based upon a working day of eight (8) hours unless otherwise so indicated. The rates for legal holidays and overtime work shall be according to local trade agreements in effect at the time of the bidding. Apprentices may be employed provided they are properly indentured in full compliance with Provision of the California

shall be observed in accordance with local trade agreements.

The minimum wage to be paid for a classification not shown above shall be not less than two dollars (\$2.00) per hour for skilled labor nor less than one dollar, forty-two and one-half cents (\$1.425) per hour for semi-skilled or unskilled labor.

Deductions from wages are allowed for the following:

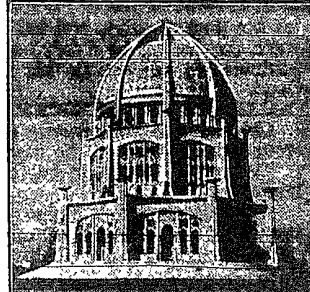
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UNITED NATIONS WEEK
