Dear Mitch:

I find no record that we have advised Aroclor for use in silo paints. I certainly hope we have not. However, I know it is in there and certainly when it was put in there nobody had any idea it would get out into the silage and proceed from there to the cow to the milk.

We have discontinued all plasticizer uses of Aroclor and that should take care of the silo usage. Whether a letter should be sent to all the silo paint manufacturers may or may not be feasible. It certainly is something that should be looked into.

Thanks for your interest in the matter. We have, of course, been dealing with the Ohio authorities, as well as some of the silo paint manufacturers.
