

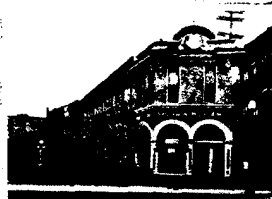

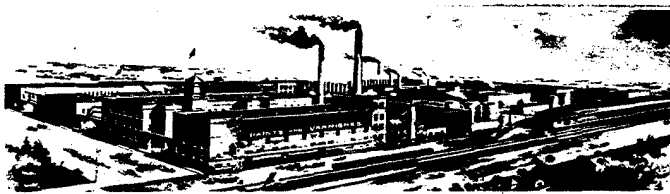

Chronological History

1909 Purchased additional land of the Pullman Co. for the extension of the Chicago plant and commenced erection of white lead works. Reorganization of officials of the Company, as follows: Henry A. Sherwin, Chairman of the Board; Walter H. Cottingham, President; S. P. Fenn, Vice-President and Treasurer; A. W. Frank, Secretary. Purchased land for the extension of the Newark plant. Opened depot at Pittsburgh, Pa. St. Louis Division made headquarters of Mississippi Valley District. Opened depot in Houston, Texas. Opened depot at New Orleans, La. Opened depot at Vancouver, B. C. Opened depot in San Antonio, Texas. Increased capital to \$8,000,000.



1910 Established factory at Detroit, Mich. Moved Chicago city office to Steger Building. Lead cor-
roding plant at Chicago complete and put into operation.



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
