

1 A Some of the workers in the population, even
2 exposures below, still presented with some disease, so
3 his value was that he considered it a tentative value
4 until further research could be done.

5 Q Now, in his references -- was there a
6 lengthy set of references that went along with the
7 Dreessen study?

8 A Yes. He has got a very extensive
9 bibliography at the end where he references the
10 published literature up until that time, and it is
11 pretty voluminous.

12 Q Did any of the references in that
13 bibliography refer to occupational cancer?

14 A Yeah. He refers to the 1935 publications
15 that we have talked about earlier demonstrating the
16 relationship between asbestos exposure and cancer.

17 Q Now, did there continue to be in the medical
18 and scientific literature any studies about that five
19 million particle per cubic foot level?

20 A Unfortunately, there are a lot of case
21 reports in the literature, but not a study that tried
