**Subject:** Avgas endangerment finding

Hi Brittany and Byron,  
I hope you two are well and have something fun planned for Labor Day weekend!

I'm emailing to follow up on our meeting from a few months ago on EPA's Endangerment Finding for Lead Emissions from Piston-Engine Aircraft Using Leaded Aviation Gasoline (Docket No.: [EPA-HQ-OAR-2007-0294](#)). I'm hearing some rumors that there might be some decisions being made on this soon. Curious if you can share anything or provide any kind of update?

As a reminder, the endangerment finding was scheduled to coincide with the conclusion of FAA's Piston Aviation Fuels Initiative (PAFI), a public-private partnership to "get the Lead out" of aviation gasoline. From what I know at FAA they still seem to be on schedule to complete PAFI by December 2018.
