

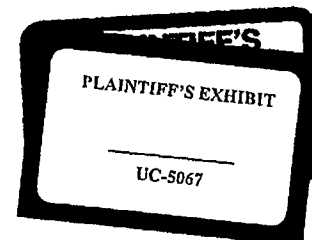

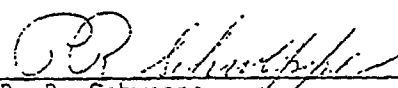

and Holders of Sections 5 and 6

SUBJECT: CENTERING ROPE FOR CLAY PIPE AND CAST IRON SOIL PIPE

Underground Valve and Piping Specifications 36W3 and 67W2 list asbestos rope or fiberglass rope to be used as centering devices for CISP and clay pipe sewer and drain systems.

Separating, handling, and cutting of asbestos rope may present safety and health problems. ~~Please discontinue purchase, stocking, and the use of asbestos ropes.~~ Fiberglass rope is available from several suppliers, e.g.; Bentley-Harris Manufacturing Company, Conshohocken, Pennsylvania (Ben-Har Thermocord). Ceramic rope, Teflon packing rope or other non-asbestos containing ropes may be used depending on economics..

Specifications 36W3 and 67W2 will be revised in the near future to eliminate the use of asbestos rope.
