Dear Mr. Bruno:

This letter is to confirm verbal information given to Mr. M. M. Hyde on October 26 and 27, 1961.

Insulation Specification IM4 Rev. 2, paragraph 4.261 limits the weather coating on surfaces inside battery limits and not covered by protective jacketing to Vinsco No. WD-1, a "breathing" type of vinyl mastic as manufactured by the Vinsco Corporation.

Since the last revision on August 14, 1961, we have come across two additional materials, which we consider equal to the Vinsco vinyl mastic material. Both will probably offer a considerable price advantage over the one specified. These two materials are; Benjamin Foster Company's "Foster Spallcoat Mastic" and Lion Oil's "Fire Retardant Seal Form".

Because of the time, I do not feel it is necessary to revise the IM4 Specification at this time, but suggest an addendum be issued to include these two materials. The fire retardant quality should be spelled out in the addendum.
