Thanks for your letter of March 3rd regarding the lack of lead warning signs and labels in Ethiopia. To my knowledge, we have never sold antiknock compound in that country, so I assume the supplier is Associated Ethyl. We feel that such matters are better handled at the local level and are reluctant to take the matter up with the Shell or Caltex people here in New York. On the other hand, we are quite willing to cooperate with Associated Ethyl but do not feel that we should do anything until they make a request.

As you can see I am sending a copy of my letter to Ray Bevan and will take no further action in the matter until I hear from him.
