This is in answer to your letter dated July 7, 1976 on the above subject. We have not as yet switched over to an Asbestos free formula and I was hoping we could wait until our new one gallon pails were in stock. At present we are applying the "do it yourself instructions" and with the Asbestos free formula it would necessitate us to stick on the Asbestos free label.

I asked our can manufacturing representative to ascertain what inventories were made up on our present one gallon can. At present they have 24,000 cans of which 20,000 will be shipped to Acme. We have 6900 empty cans in stock here making a total of 10,900 pails to still use up. This represents another two day run which we most likely will have out of the way in the next 60 days.

I am asking for permission to hold off on our formula change as outlined in my second paragraph.
