In order to conform to recently enacted federal legislation which requires a warning statement on products containing asbestos, please arrange that the following label be placed in the upper section on the back side of all Gun Plastic cement bags ordered in the future.

CAUTION

Contains Asbestos Fibers
Avoid Creating Dust
Breathing Asbestos Dust May Cause Serious
Bodily Harm

Immediately below the label but not necessarily in lettering of the same size, insert "Above label is in compliance with Federal Regulations relating to Occupational, Safety and Health Standards, 29 CFR 1910.93a."

Please advise when we can expect this notice first to appear on new bags delivered. In the meantime, I am asking Ralph Hoffman to see that our plant personnel stamp all gun plastic bags now in inventory with the suggested warning shown herein.
