Attached is letter of October 9th from Mr. W. H. Zabriskie to Mr. J. A. Brown recommending a modification in our medical arrangements at 26 Broadway.

After discussing this recommendation with Mr. Zabriskie, he concurs in the view that we might continue with the New Jersey Co. at a modified fee, say \$5000. per year instead of \$10,000. per year. This reduced fee would be more commensurate with the amount of service being rendered.

It is suggested that I discuss this subject with Dr. Denno with a view to securing his amicable concurrence in this change.

Mr. Zabriskie would like to carry out the other features of his memorandum except Paragraph 3, where he suggests an arrangement with the Broad Street Hospital. In view of the continuation of the arrangement with the New Jersey Co. this will not be necessary.
