On April 8, I introduced a bill to allow for the release of asbestos chrysotile from the national stockpile. A Canadian landslide has wiped out most of our supply of asbestos and the damage cannot be repaired for many months. The unemployment that could result warrants action by Congress as soon as possible.

I thought that your association might be interested in this legislation and I would like to know your thoughts on the problem—as described in my attached statement—and in the proposed bill. Will a shortage of asbestos affect the firms you represent?

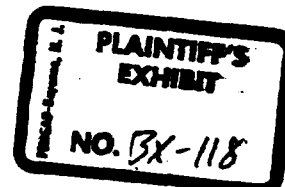
