General - Cut size boards - Equipment Accounts

At our recent meeting it was agreed you would give further consideration to the above subject and make a study of the following suggestion designed to eliminate loss on waste. I shall appreciate your comment at your earliest convenience. The following is the suggestion:

Exception -- Prices of cut sizes to Equipment Mfgs. will be figured as follows:

Base widths are 3", 4", 6", 9", 12", 18", 24", 30", 36", 42", and 48".

Base lengths are 12" up to 72" by 1" increments. Use area (from area table in License Schedule) of piece of base width and base length from which cut size can be cut. Multiply either area per piece or total area of all pieces by list price. Apply Class B discount. Add 10%. Carry such calculation to 4 decimals increasing 4th by 1 if there are more (3.62957 = 3.6296). Add 1¢ per sq. ft. (outside area) for curved sheets. Add 1¢ per sq. ft. for making cut-outs or holes.
