On September 15, 1969, we discussed the possibility of your testing two gelatin samples with Keith Baldwin and Paul Arseneau. Keith agreed to help us and suggested that we forward the samples to your attention. The samples will be shipped from Flemington and will be marked as Gelatina Duche' A and Gelatina Duche' B.

The problem, Jim, is to define first of all what Atlantic Gelatin type these samples are equivalent to, if at all. Then, we need to know from your testing results and knowledge of gelatin, technical reasons why this gelatin can or can not be utilized effectively in polyvinyl chloride polymerization recipes.

Keith will be able to provide more background information on these samples when you speak to him.
