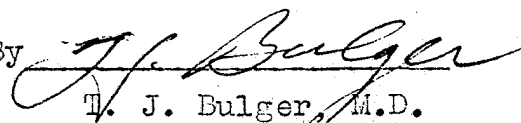
Any additional data or references that you may have in your possession on this particular exposure involving lead burning would be welcomed.
