REPORT TO THE PRESIDENT

- The committee's name has been changed to "Health and Environmental Affairs Committee".
- Three new members have been added to broaden the membership representation. They are:

 - George Bohrer, K. K. Porter Co, Thermoid Division
 - Richard Dean, Thiokol Corporation, Friction Division
- The Institutes catalog insert "Recommended Procedures for Reducing Asbestos Dust During Brake Servicing" has been revised and is being updated.
- A charter defining the duties and responsibilities of the newly named committee is being developed.
- An FMSI response to the "Consumer Product Safety Commission" and "Environmental Protection Agency" proposed rulemaking has been drafted and is undergoing committee review.
