To All:

I talked to Ms. Nonie Tao today. She mentioned there were no new cases of SARS in all parts of China yesterday and today. There are more overseas people visiting the BP Shanghai office recently. However, BP is still on the business-essential travel policy.

I informed her that Mike Markowicz and I should arrive in Shanghai on Tuesday July 22, assuming that the SARS-related travel restrictions are officially lifted by BP soon. I have requested her to make contacts again with Shanghai Jin Shan Plant for a one-day visit by Mike and I between Wednesday July 23 and Friday July 25. I also requested her to keep in contact with Dr. Dong at Da Qing who we shall visit on July 28 and 29. Mike, we should re-consider whether to spend one day (July 30) in Beijing on our way back from Da Qing.
